Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ARP ESSER)

Of the total amount allocated to an LEA from the State's ARP ESSER award, the LEA must reserve at least 20% of funds to address learning loss through **the implementation of evidence-based interventions**, ensuring that those interventions **respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs** and address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on under-represented student subgroups.
